### **United States**

- o Long-term unemployed: 2.142M, increase of 38,000 since last month (unemployed for more than 26 weeks)
- U-6 Unemployment Rate: 9.8% (U-6: total unemployed (U-3) plus discouraged workers (U-4), plus all other marginally attached workers (U-5), plus total employed part time for economic reasons (U-6))
- o There are 5.526M job openings (September 2015 preliminary). This equates to 1.4 unemployed persons per job opening, or 2.8 persons using the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

### **Nonfarm jobs**: 142.654M (84.6% private, 15.4% public)

- Monthly change: +271,000 (+268,000 private, +3,000 public)
- Largest industry growth: Health care and social assistance (+56,700), Trade, transportation, and utilities (+51,000), and Administrative and support services (+45,700)
- Average monthly job growth (total nonfarm jobs) since October 2014: +235,000
- o Compared to October 2007: 4.518M more jobs

The recession began in December 2007

#### Initial Claims: 276,000

O Weekly change: +16,000

o Annual change: -7,000

**Initial Claims**: The count of notices of unemployment requesting a determination of eligibility and entitlement for Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. A person can file multiple claims.

# **Unemployment Rate by Educational Attainment:**

- o Less than a high school diploma: 7.4%
- o High school diploma: 5.2%

- Some College or Associate Degree: 4.4%
- o Bachelor's degree and higher: 2.5%

As educational attainment levels increase, unemployment rates decrease.

- o **Nonfarm Jobs**: 5.840M (87.9% private, 12.1% public; annual change: +0.7%)
- o Regular UC Initial Claims: 59,700 (annual change: -1.3%)
- o PA U-6 unemployment rate: 10.9% (BLS, 2014Q4-2015Q3)
- There are 229,900 job openings (Conference Board Help Wanted OnLine (HWOL) dataset for September 2015). This equates to 1.5 unemployed persons per job opening, or 3.2 persons when considering the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

- Regular UC Initial Claims: 1,300 (annual change: +60.5%)
- There are 1,300 online job postings (Conference Board Help Wanted OnLine (HWOL) dataset for September 2015). This equates to 4.1 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 8.9 using an estimated U-6 unemployment rate of 12.3%.
