#### **United States**

- Long-term unemployed: 3.646M, decrease of 232,000 since last month (unemployed for more than 26 weeks)
- U-6 Unemployment Rate: 12.7% (U-6: total unemployed (U-3) plus discouraged workers (U-4), plus all other marginally attached workers (U-5), plus total employed part time for economic reasons (U-6))
- o There are 3.990M job openings (*December 2013 preliminary*). This equates to 2.6 unemployed persons per job opening, or 4.9 persons using the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

# **Nonfarm jobs**: 137.499M (84.1% private, 15.9% public)

- Monthly change: +113,000 (+142,000 private,-12,000 public)
- Largest industry growth: Construction (+48,000), Professional and business services (+36,000), and Leisure and hospitality (+24,000)
- Average monthly job growth (total nonfarm jobs) since January 2013: +187,000
- Compared to January 2007: 51,000 more jobs
   The recession began in December 2007

# **Unemployment Rate by Educational Attainment:**

- Less than a high school diploma: 9.6%
- High school diploma: 6.5%

Initial Claims: 331.000

O Weekly change: -20,000

O Annual change: -30,000

Initial Claims: The count of notices of unemployment requesting a determination of eligibility and entitlement for Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. A person can file multiple claims.

- o Some College or Associate Degree: 6.0%
- Bachelor's degree and higher: 3.2%

As educational attainment levels increase, unemployment rates decrease.

- Nonfarm Jobs: 5.762M (87.6% private, 12.4% public; annual change: +0.3%)
- o Regular UC Initial Claims: 167,200 (annual change: +10.1%)
- o PA U-6 unemployment rate: 13.4% (BLS, 2013 Annual Average)
- There are 187,500 job openings (PA JobGateway). This equates to 2.4 unemployed persons per job opening, or 4.7 persons when considering the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

- o 11<sup>th</sup> lowest rate by WIA in PA
- Nonfarm Jobs: 311,300 (87.2% private, 12.8% public; annual change: 0.0%) (NSA; includes other counties)
- o Regular UC Initial Claims: 2,600 (annual change: -3.0%) (NSA)
- There are 1,100 online job postings (Conference Board Help Wanted OnLine (HWOL) dataset for December 2013). This equates to 5.7 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 11.4 using an estimated U-6 unemployment rate of 12.6%.
