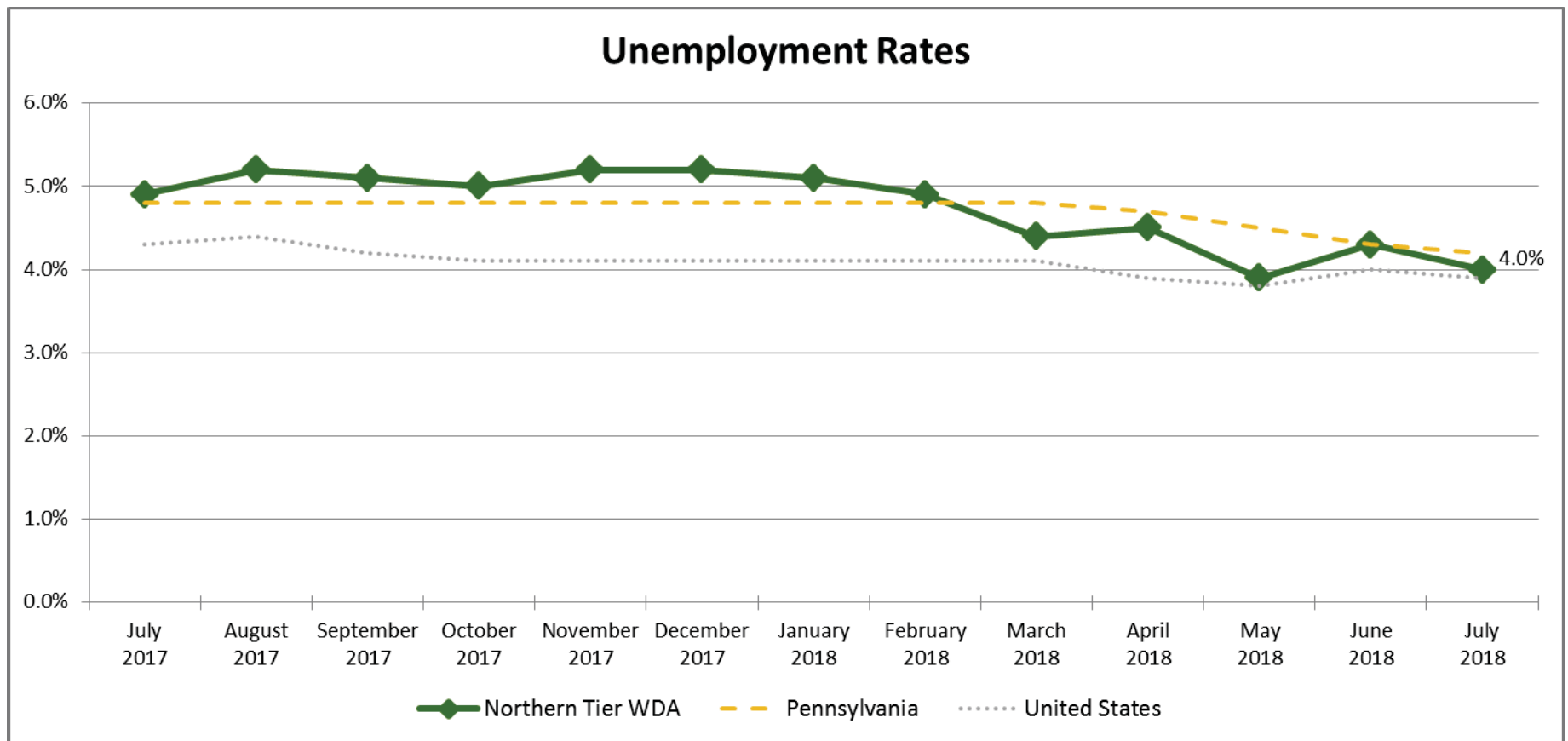

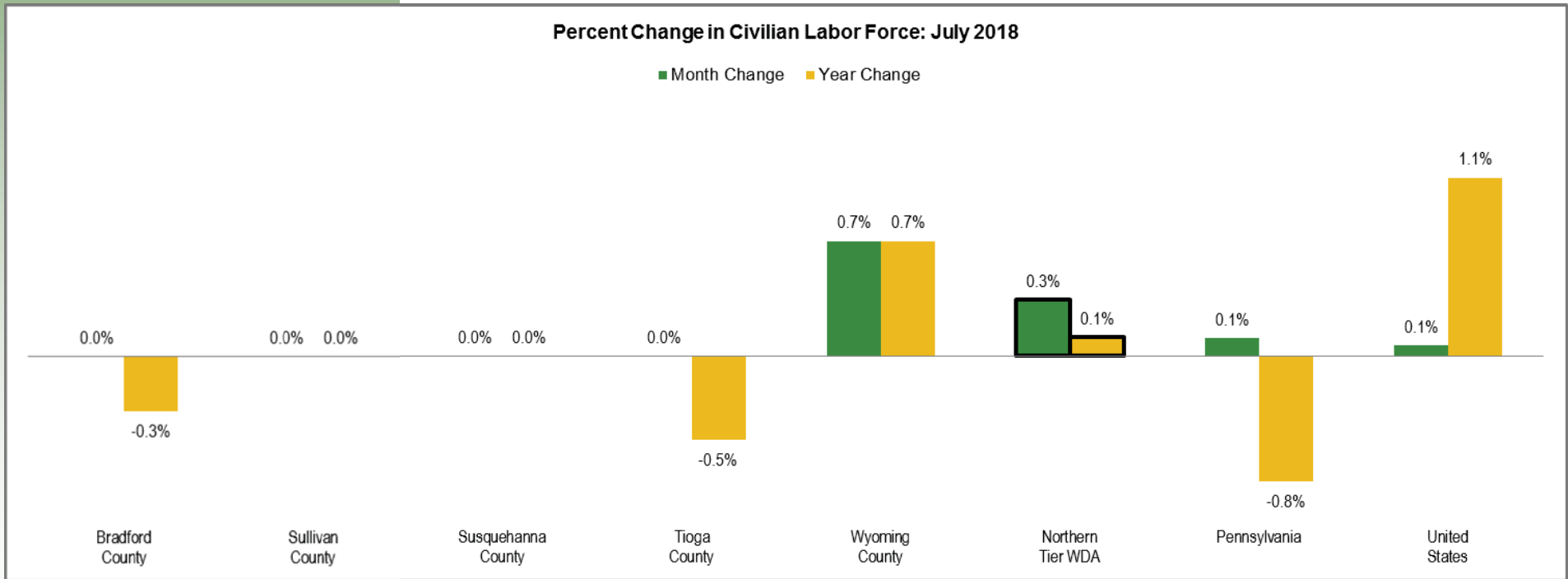


### Civilian Labor Force

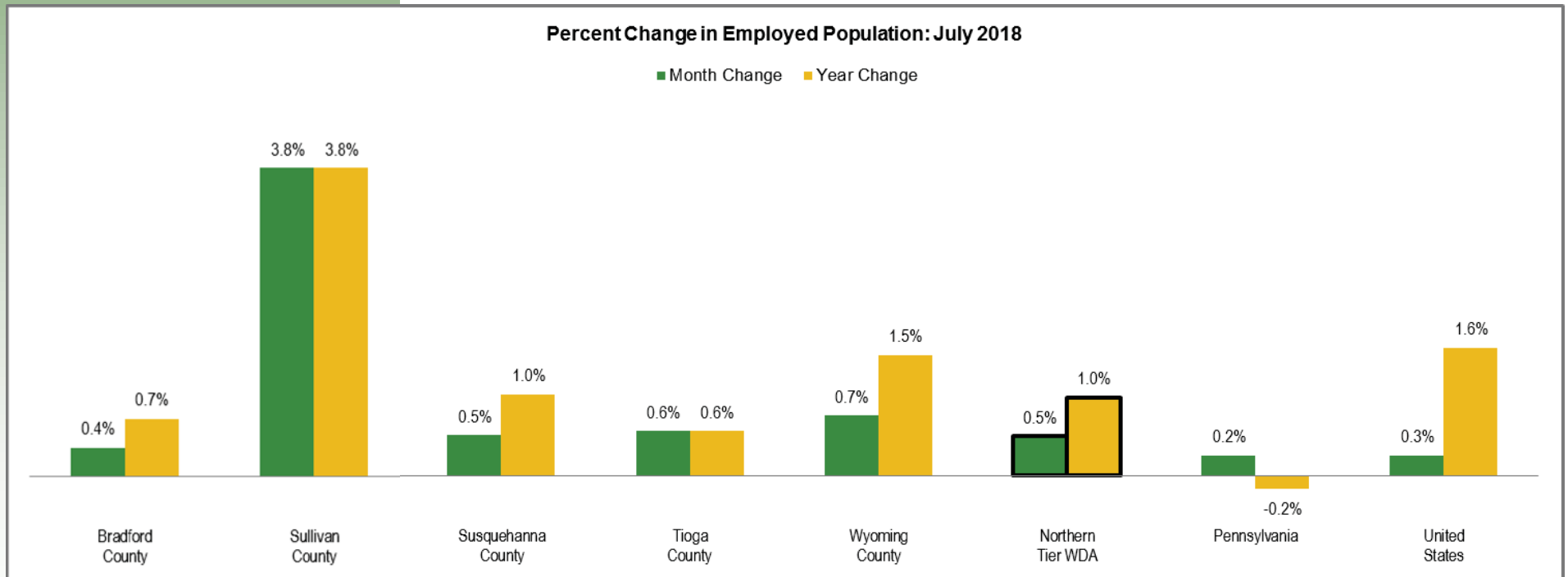

■ Month Change ■ Year Change



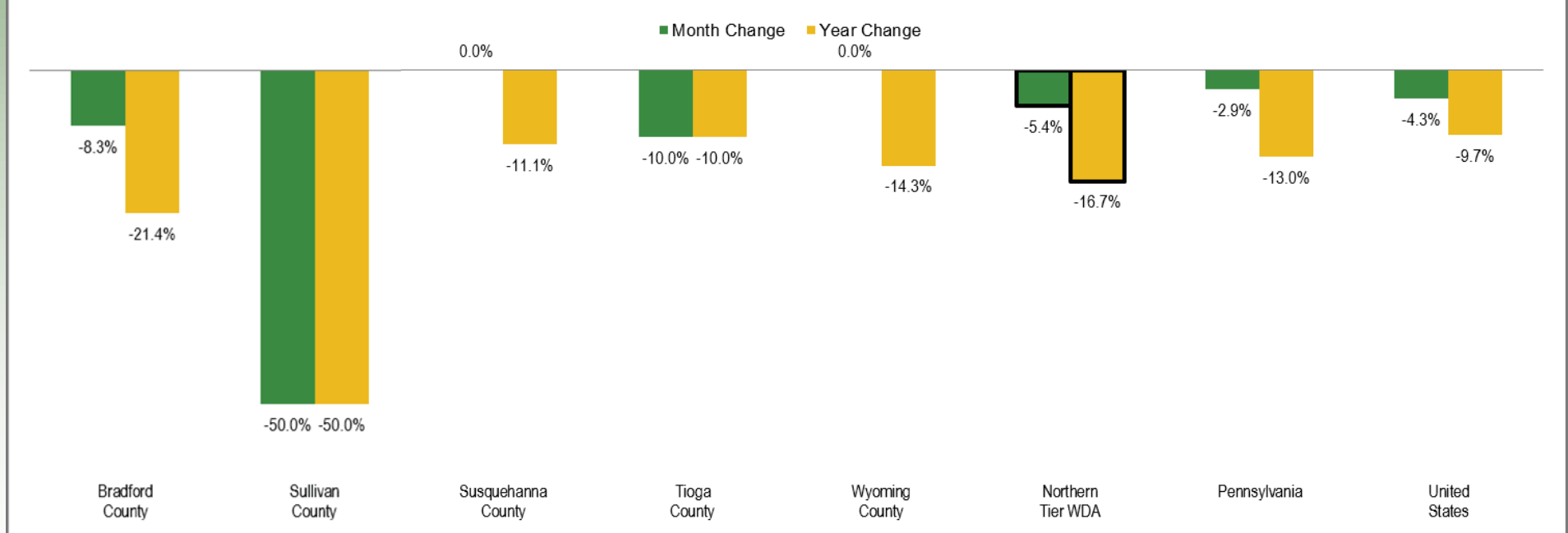
## Unemployed Population
