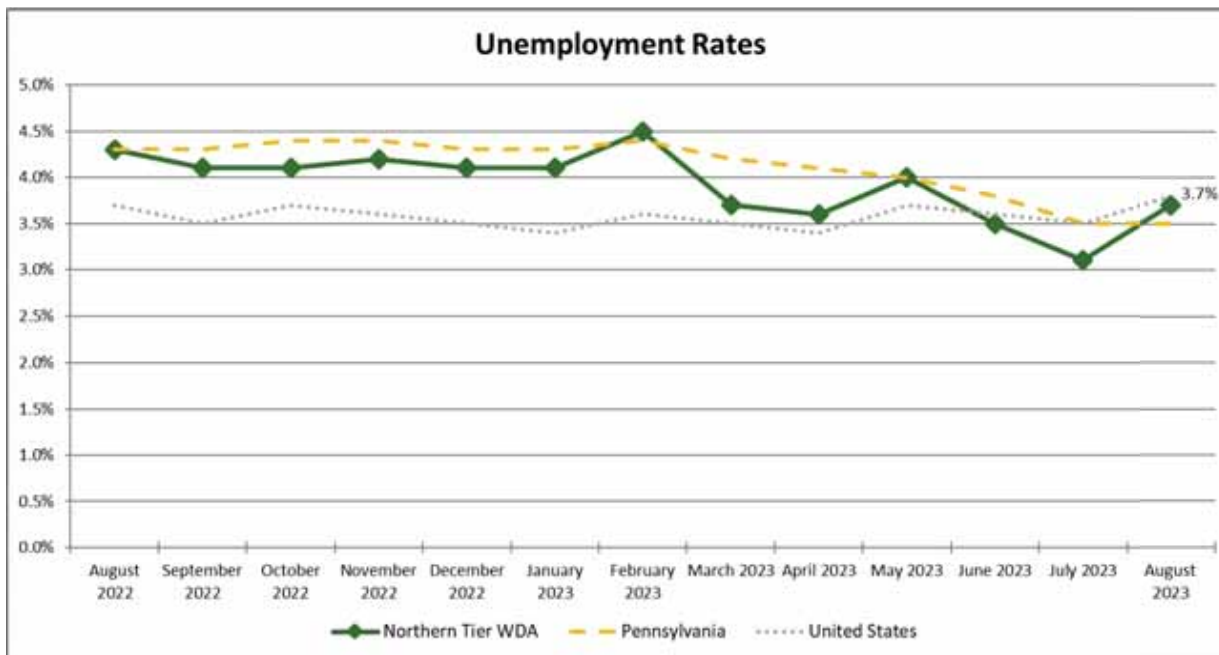

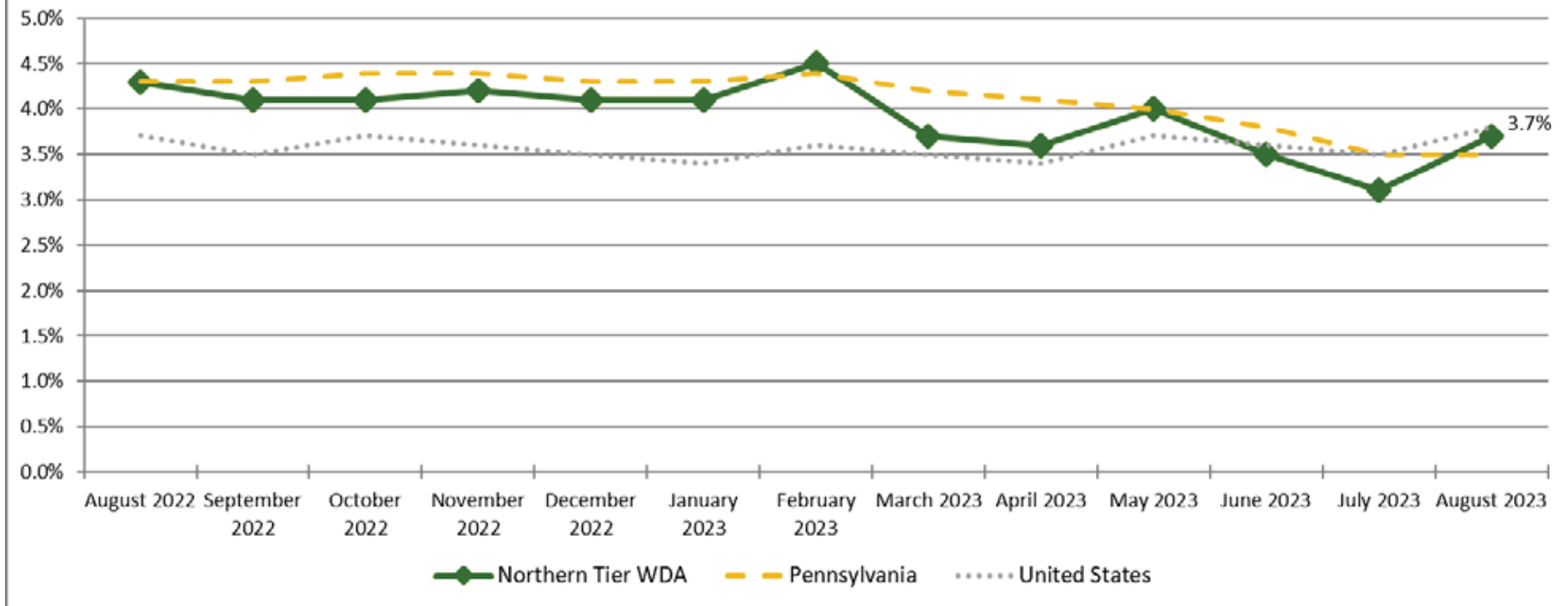

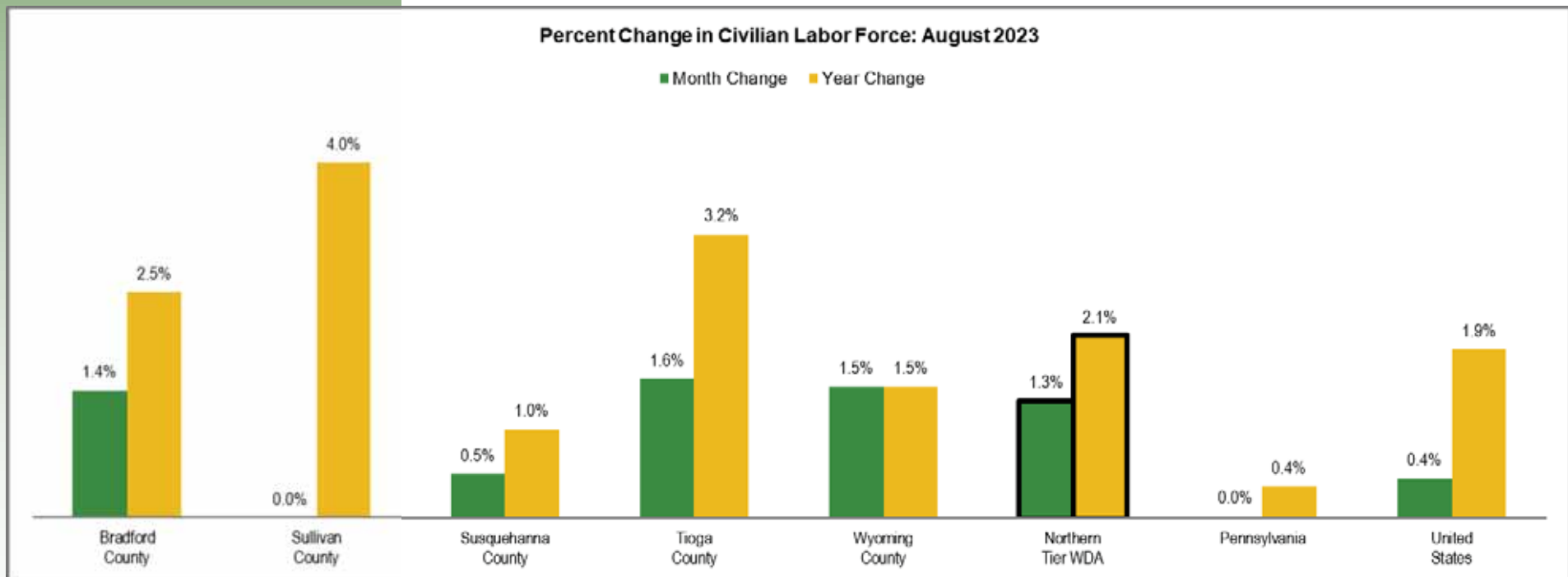


Civilian Labor Force

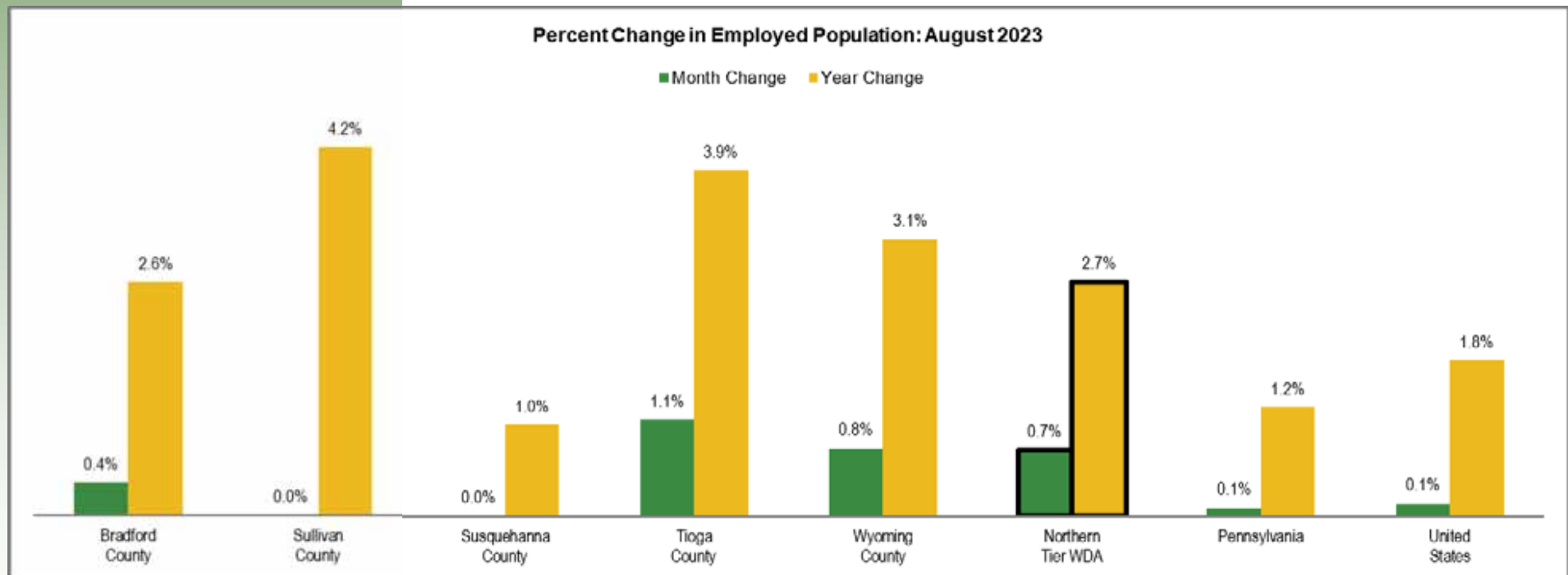

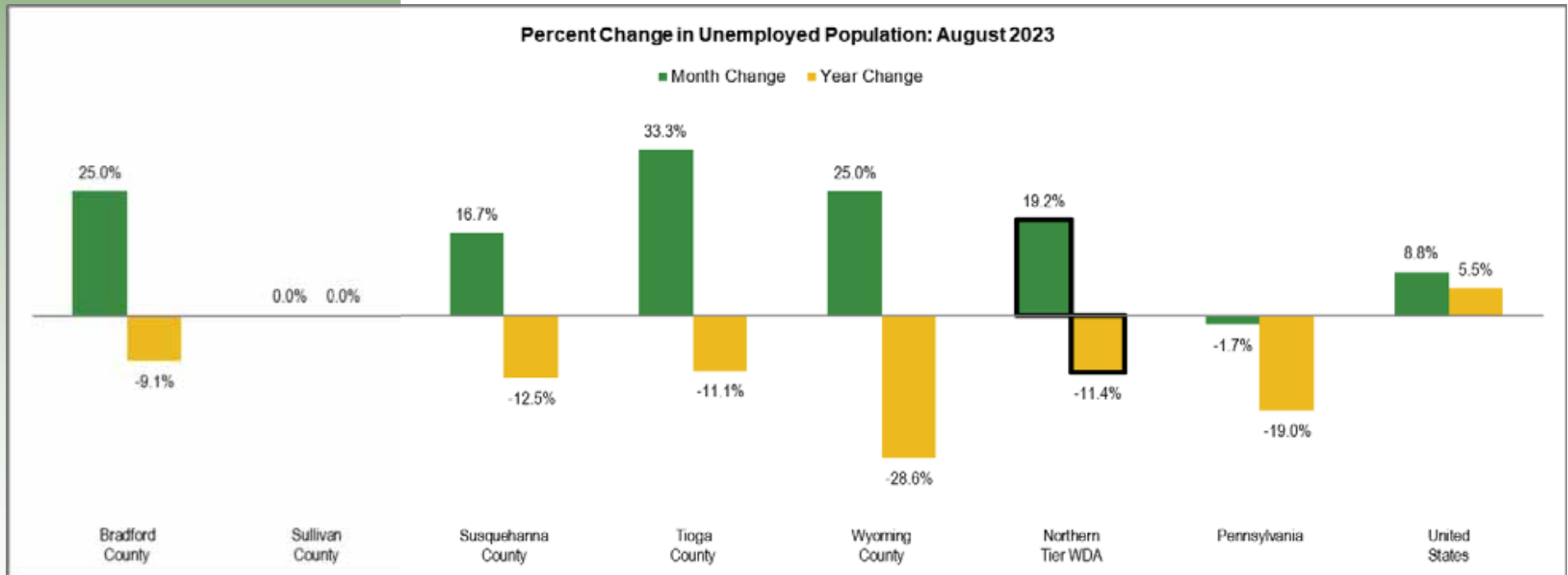


Unemployed Population
